Our client: The Valley Invicta Academies Trust

We act for The Valley Invicta Academies Trust of Huntsman Lane, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 5DS and have had forwarded to us your email timed at 11:07 hrs on 31 March 2021 addressed to the Clerk to the Trust.

The issues which you have raised in your email have all been canvassed in previous correspondence dating back to 2018; in that year our client had correspondence with the Information Commissioner's office following a complaint by you and we also were instructed to write to you regarding the website <https://www.lenham.net/>.

The letter of 3 July 2018 which our client wrote to the ICO and to which you have referred was available to you in 2018. Our client gave permission to the ICO to disclose it to you. No action was taken by the ICO in relation to our client and it was therefore clearly satisfied by the responses to the complaint which it received.


There is no evidence to suggest that Mrs Wicks acted in a "clearly malicious" manner as you suggest. We addressed the issue of Mrs Wicks' intentions in our letter to you of 23 November 2018.

You have disclosed no evidence whatsoever to link the breakdown of your marriage, your former wife's health issues or those of your son to the matters about which you make unjustified complaint. Even if, which is denied, there was any link between the health issues of your former wife and/or your son to the matter of which you make complaint, those would be issues for them to take up and not you. No such allegations have been made by them.

In the circumstances, our client's position remains as set out in our letters to you of 22 and 23 November 2018.

You may wish to consider obtaining legal advice as to your position, but our client has nothing further to say in response to your recent email which raises no issues which have not already been responded to in earlier correspondence.

We remind you that you should not make any unjustified, untrue or derogatory comments about our client or its staff in any media and that if malicious falsehoods or untrue allegations are published by you, our client will view the position as a serious one.

We trust that this is the end of the matter.
